

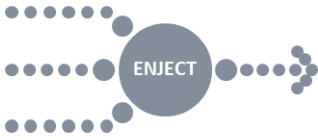

UCD - Visitor/Hourly Paid Parking

Limited visitor/hourly paid parking is available in designated car parks and charges of €1/hour capped at €3/day apply 8:00hrs-17:00hrs, Monday – Friday (excluding bank holidays) during the peak demand periods of semester 1 (7 Sept. – 27 Nov. 2015) and semester 2 (25 Jan. – 29 Apr. 2016). Outside of these hours car parking is free of charge except for premium rate hourly paid spaces and spaces associated with UCD Sports and Fitness. We do have visitor parking permits available – please contact me to arrange this in advance. Visitor/hourly paid parking is clearly signed and located as follows:

- N11 Entrance – Tierney Carpark
- Owenstown Entrance – opposite UCD Sutherland School of Law
- Newstead Entrance – opposite UCD Sports Centre

Taxis
