

Overview of Short Term Scientific Mission (STSM)
 COST Action TD 1405
 ENJECT
 (European Network for the Joint Evaluation of Connected Health Technologies)

Objective: The objective of a Short Term Scientific Mission (STSM) is exchange visits which aim to support individual mobility, to strengthen existing research networks, and to enhance collaboration between researchers and research institutions. The STSM should contribute to the scientific objectives of the Action. While the work of the Action should be the primary focus of the STSM, those undertaking it should also learn new skills and techniques and access specific data, instruments, and/or methods not readily available to them in their own institutions or organisations.

Applicant Criteria: Applicants to a STSM must be participating in an official research programme either as a PhD student or postdoctoral fellow. They can also be associated with or employed by an institution or legal entity with clear research associations. The institutions/organisations where applicants will pursue their research are called Home institutions and will host the successful applicant.

The following scenarios apply to STSM applications:

Home Institution	Host Institution

The following criteria must be followed by potential applicants:

1. They must have a minimum duration of 5 days
2. They must have a maximum duration of 90 days
3. STSM must be carried out in their entirety within a single grant period and always within the lifetime of the Action

To encourage the participation of Early Career Investigators (ECI), the following conditions must apply:

1. The mission must have a minimum duration of 91 days
2. The mission must have a maximum of 180 days
3. STSM performed by ECI must be carried out entirely within a single grant period and always within the lifetime of the Action

Evaluation: STSM applications will be evaluated by the MC or the Action Chair (or Vice-Chair if the Action Chair is affiliated with the Grant Holding Institution). The appointed STSM Coordinator /Committee can also evaluate applications if the MC gives allows them to act on the MC's behalf. All evaluation criteria should be clearly defined by the MC and communicated to all applicants.

The MC Chair, the Action Chair (or the Vice-Chair) STSM coordinator/committee will peer review the application, soliciting opinions when necessary. The following selection criteria must be addressed in the application:

- Scientific quality
- Originality of the work plan
- Training benefit for the applicant
- Benefit for the ENJECT Network

Each selection criteria will be evaluated with a maximum of 3 points; maximum quantitative result for the four selection criteria is 12 points. The minimum quantitative result acceptable for approval is 8 points; a score with 7 or less points will lead to rejection of the application. In case of rejection, the STSM coordinator informs the applicant. Resubmissions are accepted. In case of approval, the MC Chair, the Action Chair (or the Vice-Chair), or the STSM Coordinator/Committee will inform the Grant Holder by e-mail. The Grant holder will subsequently inform the successful applicants by sending them a Grant letter with an official approval of the STSM application, a "Payment Request" (to be completed after the completion of the STSM) and the level of the financial grant given. The Applicant has to notify acceptance of the grant by returning the Grant letter, with his/her signature. Note: a fixed grant is made, in line with COST regulations, and is paid after the STSM has been completed. The grant will be paid directly into the bank account entered onto the e-Cost system.

Financial Support: A STSM grant is a fixed financial contribution which considers the budget request of the applicant and the outcome of the STSM application evaluation done by the Action Chair (or Vice Chair) or the STSM Coordinator/Committee. The Grant will not necessarily cover all expenses related to carrying out the mission. It will contribute to overall travel, accommodation, and meal expenses.

The following criteria apply to the calculation of the financial contribution for each STSM:

- Up to a maximum of €2500 in total can be allocated to each successful STSM applicant
- Up to a maximum of €160 per day can be allocated for accommodation and meal expenses

For ECIs, the following criteria apply:

- Up to a maximum of €3500 in total can be funded to ECIs for a mission lasting between 91 and 180 days
- Up to a maximum of €160 per day can be allocated for accommodation and meal expenses

Based upon the cost of living in certain host countries, the Action Chair (or Vice Chair) or appointed STSM Coordinator/Committee can approve differentiated country rates to cover accommodation and meal expenses.

The STSM budget allocated to this grant period totals €20,000 for the purpose of approximately 10 STSMs.

Application Process:

1) The application deadline for this call is 31st May with notification of application outcome made by the 8th June. All STSMs for this call must be completed by 30th September 2018.

2) The travel arrangements for the STSM can be made once the official notification that the STSM was accepted is received and confirmation is achieved with Kristina Drusany Staric (drusany@yahoo.com) and Jennifer Kelly (enject@ucd.ie)

3) The applicant must obtain the agreement of the host institution before submitting the STSM application and provide a signed statement from the Host Institution (see Template 1). STSM grantees must make their own arrangements for all health, social, personal security, and pension matters.

4) The applicant needs to be registered on the e-COST, <https://e-services.cost.eu/STSM>

The applicant must use the on-line registration tool to register their request for an STSM. After encoding the information via the online registration tool, there will be issued a formal STSM application which has to be downloaded.
